Introduction

“The time has finally arrived for you to attend the greatest class trip of them all: Grad Bash. This year, Grad Bash will be a two-day trip – lasting from the early morning of Feb. 27 to the evening of Feb. 28 – to BOTH Universal Studios and Islands of Adventure theme parks in Orlando, Florida.”**

**Must have participated in school fundraiser to qualify.

Part 1: Grad Bash 2020 Requirements Process

We will have TWO days in November, November 5th & November 7th, where students will be able to submit ONLY the following (Click on “Grad Bash field trip form” and on “Contract” to access these documents).

- 1) Grad Bash field trip form AND
- 2) Contract*

*Contract outlines the following:

1. **NO** outdoor suspensions or referrals this school year or last school year
2. **Must** adhere to 10/20 rule (no more than 10 absences/20 tardies); ***10/20 rule will be checked before the trip***
3. **Must** meet GPA requirement of 2.70 UW

Things to remember:

There are only **200** spots available, so please intend on following the rules of the contract as well as turning all necessary documentation ASAP.

Both the field trip form and the contract **MUST** be filled out and turned in to Student Activities in rm. 9219 during both lunches on Nov. 5th & Nov. 7th.

Part 2: Grad Bash Requirements **Process**

Once we determine your ELIGIBILITY to attend Grad Bash, we will then add you onto a list of people that have to pay for the trip through OSP, which is the app where you pay for club and class fees on your Dadeschools Student Portal.

PLEASE NOTE:

IT WILL CLOSE ON THE 22nd OF NOVEMBER.

Again, OSP (accessible via your student portal) will be open
ONLY to those on the Grad Bash list.

**If you fail to pay the \$285 price of the trip by
the end of that time frame-- Monday through
Friday from the 18th to the 22nd-- you will lose
your spot to attend the class trip.**

Homecoming 2019!

****If you are planning on DRIVING to homecoming, be aware that the only place you can park is the **Pavia Garage** inside UM.**

Parking is NOT free anywhere on campus.

Make sure to have the “PayByPhone” app downloaded on your phone to pay for parking at the Pavia garage. The code to input into the parking app is 330209. Prior to payment, you will need to link a debit or credit card to the parking app. Parking time will be limited, so pay attention to the expiration time and update your parking to avoid receiving a \$50.00 ticket.**

Drivers' Guide on to get to Pavia Garage:

1. Go thru the main entrance of UM on Ponce De Leon Blvd. You will see a security checkpoint at the main entrance.
2. As you continue straight, you will take your first left onto Levante Ave. After 500 feet, you will face your first stop sign. Make a right at the stop sign onto Pavia Street. Once you are on Pavia Street, the Pavia Garage will be to your left.
3. The address to the Pavia garage is 5615 Pavia Street. When you enter the Pavia Garage, there will be another security checkpoint.

Drivers' Guide to getting to Homecoming ballroom:

- 1) To get to the ballroom, you will take a left out of the garage.
- 2) Follow the construction path, which will lead you University Drive.
- 3) Once you locate the Student Center to your left, make sure to walk between the Student Center and the UM Campus Store towards the food court.
- 4) After that, continue to walk straight through the food court to your right and the pool to the left.
- 5) The ballroom is right in front of the lake. As soon as you enter the **Donna E. Shalala center**, you will be presented with a large staircase in the center of the building. You can take the stairs or elevator to find the ballrooms on the third floor. When you are finally at **the 3rd floor**, you can find the ballroom to your right.

Drop-off is **HIGHLY** suggested for this event. The drop-off location is closer to the ballroom than the parking garage. If you plan on getting dropped off by Uber or a parent, you will have a different designated drop off areas. **DO NOT** go through the main entrance. The exact drop-off address you will input into maps is **1330 Miller Drive.**

Drop-off's Guide to getting to Homecoming ballroom:

- 1) To get dropped off near the ballroom, you will need to find Pizano Avenue, which runs alongside Doctors Hospital. At the first stop sign after passing the hospital, turn left onto Campo Sano Avenue.
- 2) Continue straight until the first roundabout, get off on the third exit continuing onto San Amaro Drive. San Amaro Drive will lead you to a second roundabout; take the 3rd exit allowing you to enter the University of Miami through the Miller entrance.
- 3) Once you have reached the Miller entrance, make the first left, turning right at the upcoming stop sign. Continue straight from there and the Donna E. Shalala Center will be to your right. The designation drop-off will be along that street of Miller Drive.
- 4) When you get dropped off you will walk down the pathway and follow the building all the way down to the glass doors on your right. The glass building is the Donna E. Shalala. Once you walk into the bottom floor, make sure to get to the 3rd floor to find the homecoming ballroom.
