- Date parents were married, remarried, separated, divorced or widowed
- 2021 and 2022 Tax Return & W2's
- Savings/checking account balance
- Investments excluding home and retirement accounts
- Current business value
- Current value of investment farm and/or rental properties
- 2022 Child Support paid or received
- 2022 Workers' compensation benefits
- 2022 Housing/food/living allowance for military and clergy
- Veteran's noneducation benefits
